Summer and Annual Enrollments

UTTC enrollments for summer totaled 2,084, up from 1,692 last summer. The GenEd program had the highest enrollment (451) followed by MBA (364) and CCJO (358). The host campus with the highest enrollment was UT Arlington (890) followed by UT Permian Basin (407) and UT Brownsville (251). Enrollments for the school year (fall 2004, spring 2005 and summer 2005) totaled 9,397, up from 8,345 during last school year. GenEd, again, had the highest annual enrollment (2,947) followed by CCJO (1,829) and MBA (1,384). UT Arlington also had the highest school-year enrollment (3,424), followed by UT Permian Basin (2,137) and UT Brownsville (1,052).
