

Online M.Ed. in Curriculum and Instruction Program

The University of Texas at Arlington

The University of Texas at Arlington offers the unique opportunity to complete a Master of Education in Curriculum and Instruction completely online. This degree provides opportunities for those interested in the field of education to develop effective teaching, research, and leadership skills that are congruent with an ever expanding theoretical knowledge base in the field. The program enables elementary and secondary in-service teachers to specialize in advanced coursework in their teaching fields and other professional certification areas designed to meet a variety of professional goals.

A total of 36 credit hours (12 courses) comprises the degree program. Once you have successfully completed all coursework, you will graduate with a Master of Education in Curriculum and Instruction. In addition, if you pass the appropriate TExES tests, you will also have the Reading Specialist Certification, the Master Reading Teacher Certification, and/or the English as a Second Language Endorsement. The ESL is a 12-hour, four course program that can be taken as part of this master's degree plan or separately in preparation for the ESL Endorsement TExES Test.

Students apply to UT Arlington which confers the degree upon successful completion of studies. Courses are delivered via the UT TeleCampus, a central support unit for online education within the University of Texas System. Core to the design of the UT TeleCampus is service and the necessity to provide increased

access to education without compromising the quality and integrity of the educational offerings.

The TeleCampus features an award-winning website similar in design to a traditional campus with admissions links, a digital library and student support services. Students interact via chatrooms and Internet-based group activities and research projects. Courses run on a semester schedule in keeping with the academic calendars of the UT System.
