

Master's Degree in Kinesiology Online

The U.S. Distance Learning Association presented its 2002 Excellence in Distance Learning Programming - Higher Education Award to the Master's Degree in Kinesiology Online, UT TeleCampus Program. This program gives you the choice of four degree plans and the flexibility of online instruction via the UT TeleCampus (UTTC). The combined resources of six University of Texas System universities allow you access to online graduate courses designed to meet your academic, professional and lifestyle needs as a physical educator, a coach, or other professional interested in the science of people in motion.

Students wanting to participate in the online Master's Degree in Kinesiology should apply for admission to one of the four University of Texas System universities offering the degree, enroll and complete that institution's degree requirements. Through a consortium of six UT System universities, there is sufficient coursework offered so that all courses can be completed online. Any of the online graduate courses offered will be accepted by each participating university for any of its Kinesiology online degree-seeking students.

The UT TeleCampus is a central support unit for online education within the University of Texas System. The TeleCampus features an award-winning website with everything you need to participate. In it you'll find admission, registration and financial aid information, as well as links to virtual classrooms, the TeleCampus digital



library and student support services.

Courses are delivered via the UTTC website and contain multimedia and creative instructional technology. Students interact via chatrooms and Internet-based group activities and research projects. Class size is limited to encourage high levels of student-to-professor and student-to-student interaction. Courses run on a semester schedule in keeping with the academic calendars of the UT System.
